## 1.0 Policy

It is Ironwood's policy to describe how we use cookies on our various websites (collectively, "Site"). This Cookie Policy ("Policy") should be read in conjunction with our [Privacy Policy](#). By continuing to use our website and its services, you acknowledge that you understand this Policy and consent to the use of cookies as described. To manage the use of cookies on this website, please continuing reading.

We reserve the right to make changes to this Policy at any time. In the event we make material changes to the Policy, we will provide notice on the Site. Changes will be effective immediately upon posting and will apply to your use of the Site after the "effective date" listed above

## 2.0 Definition of "Cookie"


A cookie is a small file consisting of letters and numbers. This file uniquely identifies and recognizes your browser or device and transmits this information back to the server.

Depending on the type of cookie, it may perform various functions such as remembering the contents of your shopping cart or your preferences, customizing your experience while you visit the website, recording the website pages you view, remembering the name or address you entered during a visit, or delivering ads that are targeted to your interests and browsing activity.

## 3.0 Types of Cookies

This section of our Policy describes the types of cookies we use, who places them on your computer or device when you browse our Site, how long the cookie lasts once it is placed on your computer or device, and what the cookies do:

1 <sup>st</sup> party cookie	A 1 <sup>st</sup> party cookie is generally placed on your computer or device by the website you are visiting. For example, we may use a 1 <sup>st</sup> party cookie to improve website security.
3 <sup>rd</sup> party cookie	A 3 <sup>rd</sup> party cookie is placed on your computer or device by a source other than the website you are visiting in order to enable third-party features. For example, this may include advertising, analytics, videos, or interactive content.
Session cookie	A session cookie is temporary and lasts only as long as you visit the website. The web browser typically deletes the information contained in a session cookie once you close your browser.
Persistent cookie	A persistent cookie remains on your device after you close your browser. These cookies expire based on a predetermined date, length of time, or when you manually delete them.  Each time you visit the website that set the cookie, or you view an advertisement from that website while visiting a different website, the cookie is activated and transmits information back to the party that served the cookie.
Essential cookies	Essential cookies are necessary to make the website work and you cannot disable them. For example, these cookies may help you navigate around the website or visit a secure area within the site.
Performance and Functionality cookies	Although these are non-essential cookies, they help the website perform and function as designed. For example, performance and functionality cookies may

	help the website display videos, enable chat sessions, or recognize whether you visited the website before.
Analytics cookies	Analytics cookies track your usage of a website. The information these cookies collect can be used for various purposes such as understanding how visitors use the website, site and content customization, or advertising and marketing.
Advertising/Marketing cookies	Advertising and marketing cookies may perform functions such as helping customize your website experience, personalizing ads based on your online activities and interests, measuring the effectiveness of ads, and preventing an ad from reappearing. Information from these cookies may be shared with third parties or third parties may place these cookies on your computer or device. Advertising and marketing cookies may track your online activities.
Social Media cookies	These cookies permit you to share content from a website on a social media platform. Social media cookies may place third party cookies on your device for tracking and advertising purposes, including building a profile on you.


#### 4.0 How Ironwood Manages Cookies

We use essential cookies on our website to make the Site function, and we use analytics cookies to understand how you use the Site, improve its functionality and for other related purposes. We also use advertising/marketing cookies on the Site to help us with marketing activities. Some of these cookies may follow you when you leave the Site and travel to other websites so that we can serve targeted and relevant ads to you.

We may place some of these cookies on your computer or devices. Third parties such as our advertising partners or service providers may also place cookies on your devices when you visit our website.
